Glory ye in His holy name: let the heart of them rejoice that seek the LORD. Seek the LORD, and His strength: seek His face evermore. Remember His marvellous works that He hath done; His wonders, and the judgments of His mouth:

Psalms 89:1 I will sing of the mercies of the LORD forever: with my mouth will I make known Thy faithfulness to all generations.

Psalms 96:2-3 Sing unto the LORD, bless His name; shew forth His salvation from day to day [be exemplary]. Declare His glory among the heathen, His wonders among all people.

Psalms 145:1-9 I will extol thee, my God, O king; and I will bless Thy name for ever and ever. Every day will I bless thee; and I will praise Thy name for ever and ever. Great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised; and His greatness is unsearchable. One generation shall praise Thy works to another, and shall declare Thy mighty acts. I will speak of the glorious honour of Thy majesty, and of Thy wondrous works. And men shall speak of the might of Thy terrible acts and I will declare Thy greatness. They shall abundantly utter the memory of Thy great goodness, and shall sing of Thy righteousness. The LORD is gracious, and full of compassion; slow to anger, and of great mercy. The LORD is good to all: and His tender mercies are over all His works.

Psalms 145:10-21 All Thy works shall praise Thee, O LORD; and Thy saints shall bless Thee. They shall speak of the glory of Thy kingdom, and talk of Thy power; To make known to the sons of men His mighty acts, and the glorious majesty of His kingdom. Thy kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and Thy dominion endureth throughout all generations. The LORD upholdeth all that fall, and raiseth up all those that be bowed down. The eyes of all wait upon Thee; and Thou givest them their meat in due season. Thou openest Thine hand, and satisfiest the desire of every living thing. The LORD is righteous in all His ways, and holy in all his works. The LORD is nigh unto all them that call upon Him, to all that call upon Him in truth. He will fulfil the desire of them that fear Him: He also will hear their cry, and will save them. The LORD preserveth all them that love Him: but all the wicked will He destroy. My mouth shall speak the praise of the LORD: and let all flesh bless His holy name for ever and ever.

Psalms 126:1-6 When the LORD turned again the captivity of Zion, we were like them that dream. Then was our mouth filled with laughter, and our tongue with singing: then said they among the heathen, The LORD hath done great things for them. The LORD hath done great things for us; whereof we are glad. Turn again our captivity, O LORD, as the streams in the south. They that sow in tears shall reap in joy. He that goeth forth and weepeth, bearing precious seed, shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, bringing his sheaves with him.

1 Peter 3:15-16 But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear: Having a good conscience; that, whereas they speak evil of you, as of evildoers, they may be ashamed that falsely accuse your good conduct in Christ.

Typos, Hypodeigma, Mimetes

Strong's Greek Dictionary 5179. τυπος tupos

from 5180; a die (as struck), i.e. (by implication) a stamp or scar; by analogy, a shape, i.e. a statue, (figuratively) style or resemblance; specially, a sampler ("type"), i.e. a model (for imitation) or instance (for warning):—en-(ex-)ample, fashion, figure, form, manner, pattern, print.

Let us labour therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same **example** [hupodeigma] of unbelief.

Hebrews 4:11

Strong's Greek Dictionary 3402. μιμητης mimetes from 3401; an imitator:—follower.

I do not write these things to shame you, but as my beloved sons I warn you...I beseech you therefore, **be imitators** [*mimetes*] of me.

1 Corinthians 4:14,16

We desire that each one of you show the same diligence...imitators [mimetes] of those who through faith and patience inherit the promises

Hebrews 6:11-12

Even as I please all men in all things, not seeking mine own profit, but the profit of many, that they may be saved. Be imitators [mimetes] of me, just as I also am of Christ.

1 Corinthians 10:33; 11:1

You...know how you ought to **follow our example** [*mimeomai*], because we did not act in an undisciplined manner...**in order to offer ourselves as a model** [*typos*] **for you, that you might follow our example** [*mimeomai*].

2 Thessalonians 3:7-9

Remember those who led you, who spoke the word of God to you; and consider the result of their conduct, **imitate** [mimeomai] their faith

Hebrews 13:7

Those things which you have learned, and received, and heard, and seen in me, do...

Philippians 4:9

Take, my brethren, the prophets, who have spoken in the name of the Lord, for an example of suffering affliction, and of patience.

James 5:10

...When you received the word of God which you heard from us, you received it...for what it really is...For you, brethren, became imitators of the churches of God which in Judaea are in Christ Jesus

1 Thessalonians 2:13-14

Be imitators of God, as dear children; and walk in love, just as Christ also loved us, and gave Himself for us...

Ephesians 5:1-2

Ye are our epistle written in our hearts, known and read of all men: Forasmuch as ye are manifestly declared to be the epistle of Christ ministered by us, written not with ink, but with the Spirit of the living God; not in tables of stone, but in fleshy tables of the heart.

2 Timothy 2:24-26




