Ezra 7:12

<u>Artaxerxes</u>, king of kings, unto Ezra the priest, a scribe of the law of the God of heaven, perfect peace, and at such a time.

Ezekiel 26:7

For thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I will bring upon Tyrus <u>Nebuchadrezzar</u> king of Babylon, **a** king of kings, from the north, with horses, and with chariots, and with horsemen, and companies, and much people.

Thou, O king [<u>Nebuchadrezzar</u>], art **a king of kings**: for the God of heaven hath given thee a kingdom, power, and strength, and glory.

Job 19:25

Thus saith the LORD the King of Israel, and his **redeemer** the LORD of hosts; <u>I am the first, and</u> <u>I am the last</u>; and beside me there is no God.

2 Samuel 22:3

The God of my rock; in him will I trust: he is my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my high tower, and my refuge, **my saviour**; thou savest me from violence.

1 Peter 1:18-19

Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:

Colossians 2:9–10


For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily. And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power:

God is not trying to trick us.



Exodus 20:3-5

Thou shalt have **no other gods before Me**.

Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me;

Mark 4:10–12

And when he was alone, they that were about him with the twelve asked of him the parable. And he said unto them, Unto you it is given to know the mystery of the kingdom of God: but unto them that are without, all these things are **done in parables**: That seeing they may see, and not perceive; and hearing they may hear, and not understand; lest at any time they should be converted, and their sins should be forgiven them.

James 4:17

Therefore to him that **knoweth to do good**, and **doeth it not**, to him it is sin.

John 9:41

Jesus said unto them, **If ye were blind, ye should have no sin**: but now ye say, **We see; therefore your sin remaineth**.



Luke 12:47

And that servant, which **knew** his lord's will, and **prepared not** himself, **neither did** according to his will, shall be **beaten with many stripes**. But he that **knew not**, and **did commit** things worthy of stripes, shall be **beaten with few stripes**.

John 15:22-23

If I had not come **and spoken** unto them, they **had not had sin**: but **now they have no cloke for their sin**. He that hateth me hateth my Father also.

1 John 5:18–21

We know that whosoever is born of God sinneth not; but he that is **begotten of God keepeth** himself, and that wicked one toucheth him not. And we know that we are of God, and the whole world lieth in wickedness. And we know that the **Son of God is come**, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, even in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life. Little children, keep yourselves from idols. Amen.

- Jesus is shown to be **Savior and Redeemer of all mankind** a title exclusive to God.
- Types and Shadows point to Jesus. **Jesus isn't a type or shadow** of anything. He is the fullness.
- God isn't trying to trick us into idolatry

Jesus is The Son of God, not God The Father



Luke 1:35

And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also **that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God**.



John 9:35–38

Jesus heard that they had cast him out; and when he had found him, he said unto him, Dost thou believe on the **Son of God**? He answered and said, Who is he, Lord, that I might believe on him? And Jesus said unto him, Thou hast both seen him, and it is he that talketh with thee. And he said, Lord, I believe. And he worshipped him.

John 5:19

Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, **The Son can do nothing of himself**, but what he seeth the Father do: **for what things soever** <u>He doeth</u>, **these also** <u>doeth the Son likewise</u>.

John 14:28

Ye have heard how I said unto you, I go away, and come again unto you. If ye loved me, ye would rejoice, because I said, <u>I go unto the</u> <u>Father</u>: for my Father is greater than I.

John 6:37

All that **the Father giveth me** shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out.

John 13:3

Jesus knowing that the Father had given all things into his hands, and that he was come from God, and went to God;

John 16:28

I came forth from the Father, and am <u>come</u> into the world: again, I leave the world, and go to the Father.

John 17:1–3

These words spake Jesus, and lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, Father, the hour is come; glorify thy Son, that thy Son also may glorify thee: As thou hast given him power over all flesh, that he should give eternal life to as many as thou hast given him. And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent.
