HIS ONLY SON: The Fulfillment of Prophetic Israel Both Israel and Jesus Referred to as the Son of God Psalm 89:27 Also I will make him my firstborn, higher than the kings of the earth.

John 3:16 "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life."

Philippians 2:9-10 Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth;



THE FULFILLMENT OF PROPHETIC ISRAEL

Both Israel and Jesus Referred to as the Son of God

Matthew 2:14-15 When he arose, he took the young child and his mother by night, and departed into Egypt: And was there until the death of Herod: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying, Out of Egypt have I called my son.

Hosea 11:1 When Israel was a child, then I loved him, and called my son out of Egypt. Matthew 8:29 And, behold, they cried out, saying, What have we to do with thee, JESUS, THOU SON OF GOD? art thou come hither to torment us before the time?

HIS ONLY SON: The Fulfillment of Prophetic Israel

Psalm 2:6-9 Yet have I set my king upon my holy hill of Zion. I will declare the decree: the LORD hath said unto me, THOU ART MY SON; THIS DAY HAVE I BEGOTTEN THEE. Ask of me, and I shall give thee the heathen for thine inheritance, and the uttermost parts of the earth for thy possession. Thou shalt break them with a rod of iron; thou shalt dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel.

Acts 13:33 God hath

fulfilled the same unto us their children, in that he hath raised up Jesus again; as it is also written in the second psalm, THOU ART MY SON, THIS DAY HAVE I BEGOTTEN THEE. HIS ONLY SON: The Fulfillment of Prophetic Israel

Matthew 3:16-17 And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him: And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is MY BELOVED SON, in whom I am well pleased.

Acts 13:33 God hath fulfilled the same unto us their children, in that he hath raised up Jesus again; as it is also written in the second psalm, THOU ART **MY SON, THIS DAY HAVE I BEGOTTEN THEE.**

2 Peter 1:17-18 For he received from God the Father honour and glory, when there came such a voice to him from the excellent glory, This is MY BELOVED SON, in whom I am well pleased. And this voice which came from heaven we heard, when we were with him in the holy mount.

HIS ONLY SON: The Fulfillment of Prophetic Israel

✓ John 3:18 "He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the **only begotten Son of God**." ✓ John 9:35-38 "Jesus heard that they had cast him out; and when he had found him, he said unto him, Dost thou believe on **the Son of God**? He answered and said, Who is he, Lord, that I might believe on him? And Jesus said unto him, Thou hast both seen him, and it is he that talketh with thee. And he said, Lord, I believe. And he worshipped him." ✓ Acts 9:20 "And straightway he preached Christ in the synagogues, that he is the Son of God."



THE FULFILLMENT OF PROPHETIC ISRAEL

Exodus 4:22 And thou shalt say unto Pharaoh, Thus saith the LORD, Israel is my son, even my firstborn:

Romans 8:29 For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of HIS SON, that he might be THE FIRSTBORN among many brethren.

Colossians 1:13-15 Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated *us* into the kingdom of his dear **Son**: In whom we have redemption through his blood, *even* the forgiveness of sins: Who is the image of the invisible God, **the firstborn** of every creature:



THE FULFILLMENT OF PROPHETIC ISRAEL Both Israel and Jesus Referred to as a Light

Isaiah 42:6 I the LORD have called thee in righteousness, and will hold thine hand, and will keep thee, and give thee for a covenant of the people, for a light of the Gentiles;

Luke 2:30-32 For mine eyes have seen thy salvation, Which thou hast prepared before the face of all people; A light to lighten the **Gentiles**, and the glory of thy people Israel.



The Fulfillment of Prophetic Israel

Isaiah 7:13-14 And he said, Hear ye now, O house of David; Is it a small thing for you to weary men, but will ye weary my God also? Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.

Matthew 1:20-21 But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost. And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name **JESUS**: for he shall save his people from their sins. Matthew 1:23 Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us.



2 Corinthians 1:20 For all the promises of God in him *are* yea, and in him Amen, unto the glory of God by us.

Hosea 6:1-2 Come, and let us return unto the LORD: for he hath torn, and he will heal us; he hath smitten, and he will bind us up. After two days will he revive us: in the third day he will raise us up, and we shall live in his sight.

Mark 14:58 We heard him say, I will destroy this temple that is made with hands, and within three days I will build another made without hands.

John 2:19 Jesus answered and said unto them, Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up.

HIS ONLY SON: The Fulfillment of Prophetic Israel

Deuteronomy 8:2-4 And thou shalt remember all the way which the LORD thy God led thee these FORTY YEARS in the wilderness, to humble thee, and to prove thee, to know what was in thine heart, whether thou wouldest KEEP HIS COMMANDMENTS, or no. And he humbled thee, and suffered thee to HUNGER, and fed thee with MANNA, which thou knewest not, neither did thy fathers know; that he might make thee know that MAN DOTH NOT LIVE BY BREAD ONLY, BUT BY EVERY WORD THAT PROCEEDETH OUT OF THE MOUTH OF GOD. Thy raiment waxed not old upon thee, neither did thy foot swell, these FORTY YEARS.



THE FULFILLMENT OF PROPHETIC ISRAEL Matthew 4:2-4 And when he had fasted FORTY DAYS and forty nights, he was afterward an HUNGRED. And when the TEMPTER came to him, he said, If thou be the Son of God, command that these STONES be made BREAD. But he answered and said, It is written, MAN SHALL NOT LIVE BY BREAD ALONE, BUT BY EVERY WORD THAT PROCEEDETH OUT OF THE MOUTH OF GOD.



THE FULFILLMENT OF PROPHETIC ISRAEL Israel's Rebellion and Restoration

Foreshadows Christ's Redemption

•Old Testament: Hosea 3:5 (KJV) - "Afterward shall the children of Israel return, and seek the Lord their God, and David their king; and shall fear the Lord and his goodness in the latter days."Amos 9:11 (KJV) "In that day will I raise up the tabernacle of David that is fallen, and close up the breaches thereof; and I will raise up his ruins, and I will build it as in the days of old:" •New Testament: Acts 15:16-17 (KJV) - "After this I will return,

and will build again the tabernacle of David, which is fallen down; and I will build again the ruins thereof, and I will set it up: That the residue of men might seek after the Lord, and all the Gentiles, upon whom my name is called, saith the Lord, who doeth all these things."



THE FULFILLMENT OF PROPHETIC ISRAEL

Israel's Priesthood Prefigures Christ's High Priesthood

•Old Testament: Exodus 28:1 (KJV) - "And take thou unto thee Aaron thy brother, and his sons with him, from among the children of Israel, that he may minister unto me in the **priest's office**, even Aaron, Nadab and Abihu, Eleazar and Ithamar, Aaron's sons." •New Testament: Hebrews 4:14 (KJV) - "Seeing then that we have a great **high priest**, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our profession."



THE FULFILLMENT OF PROPHETIC ISRAEL Israel as a Nation Called to Reflect God's Character

•Old Testament: Isaiah 43:10 (KJV) - "Ye are my witnesses, saith the Lord, and my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and believe me, and understand that I am he: before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me."

•New Testament: Acts 1:8 (KJV) - "But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth."



Israel's Covenant with God Prefigures Christ's New Covenant

•Old Testament: Jeremiah 31:31 (KJV) - "Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, that I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah." •New Testament: Hebrews 8:6-7 (KJV) - "But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also he is the mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises. For if that first covenant had been faultless, then should no place have been sought for the second."



Isaiah 53:3 (KJV): "He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not."

Corresponding New Testament Verse:

•John 1:11(KJV) "He came unto his own, and his own received him not. "

•Matthew 27:25 (KJV) "Then answered all the people, and said, His blood *be* on us, and on our children."



Isaiah 53:5-6 But he *was* wounded for our transgressions, *he was* bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace *was* upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all. (Also verses 8 & 12 for the transgression of my people)

Romans 4:25 Who was **delivered for our offences**, and was raised again for our justification.

1 Peter 2:24-25 Who his own self **bare our sins in his own body** on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: **by whose stripes ye were healed.** For ye were as sheep going astray; but are now returned unto the Shepherd and Bishop of your souls.



Isaiah 53:7 (KJV): "He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth."

Corresponding New Testament Verse:

•Acts 8:32-33 (KJV) - "The place of the scripture which he read was this, He was led as a sheep to the slaughter; and like a lamb dumb before his shearer, so opened he not his mouth: In his humiliation his judgment was taken away: and who shall declare his generation? for his life is taken from the earth."



Isaiah 53:9 (KJV) "And he made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death; because he had done no violence, neither was any deceit in his mouth."

Matthew 27:38 (KJV) "Then were there two thieves crucified with him, one on the right hand, and another on the left."

Matthew 27:57-60 (KJV) "When the even was come, there came a rich man of Arimathaea, named Joseph, who also himself was Jesus' disciple: He went to Pilate, and begged the body of Jesus. Then Pilate commanded the body to be delivered. And when Joseph had taken the body, he wrapped it in a clean linen cloth, And laid it in his own new tomb, which he had hewn out in the rock: and he rolled a great stone to the door of the sepulchre, and departed."



Isaiah 53:12 (KJV): "Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he hath poured out his soul unto death: and he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors."

Corresponding New Testament Verse:

•Mark 15:27-28 (KJV) - "And with him they crucify two thieves; the one on his right hand, and the other on his left. And the scripture was fulfilled, which saith, And he was numbered with the transgressors."



Psalm 22 Israel's King David Prefigures Jesus as Messiah

- Psalm 22:1 (KJV): "My God, my God, why hast thou
- forsaken me? why art thou so far from helping me, and from the words of my roaring?"
- **Corresponding New Testament Verse:**
- •Matthew 27:46 (KJV) "And about the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? that is to say, My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?"



Psalm 22 Israel's King David Prefigures Jesus as Messiah

Psalm 22:16 (KJV): "For dogs have compassed me: the assembly of the wicked have enclosed me: they pierced my hands and my feet."

Corresponding New Testament Verse:

•John 20:25 (KJV) - "The other disciples therefore said unto him, We have seen the Lord. But he said unto them, Except I shall see in his hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and thrust my hand into his side, I will not believe."



THE FULFILLMENT OF PROPHETIC ISRAEL Deliverance from Bondage

Israel: The Exodus of the Israelites from slavery in Egypt is a type of deliverance from physical bondage.

Jesus: Christ brings spiritual deliverance from the bondage of sin for all who believe in Him. (John 8:36, KJV)



THE FULFILLMENT OF PROPHETIC ISRAEL Passover Lamb

Israel: The Passover lamb was sacrificed to spare the Israelites from the angel of death.

Jesus: Jesus is the ultimate Passover Lamb whose sacrifice offers salvation from spiritual death. (1 Corinthians 5:7, KJV)



THE FULFILLMENT OF PROPHETIC ISRAEL Bread from Heaven

Israel: God provided manna to sustain the Israelites in the wilderness.

Jesus: Jesus, the Bread of Life, provides spiritual sustenance and eternal life to those who partake of Him. (John 6:35, KJV)



THE FULFILLMENT OF PROPHETIC ISRAEL Promised Inheritance

Israel: The role of the **high priest** in offering sacrifices for the people's sins.

Jesus: Jesus serves as the High Priest who offers Himself as the perfect sacrifice for the sins of humanity. (Hebrews 4:14-16, KJV)



THE FULFILLMENT OF PROPHETIC ISRAEL The Prophets

Israel: The Old Testament prophets pointed to the coming Messiah.

Jesus: Jesus is the fulfillment of those prophecies, the ultimate Prophet, and the Messiah. (Matthew 16:13-16, KJV)



THE FULFILLMENT OF PROPHETIC ISRAEL The Tabernacle & Temple

Israel: The tabernacle and temple were places of worship and God's presence.

Jesus: Jesus is the true temple (John 2:19, KJV) and the means through which humanity can access God's presence and receive salvation.



THE FULFILLMENT OF PROPHETIC ISRAEL Blood Covenant

Israel: The Old Covenant with Israel was fulfilled and surpassed by the New Covenant in Christ's blood. (Blood of the Covenant Ex24:8; blood of bulls & goats see Lev 16: 3, 9, 11, 15)

Psalm 50:13-14 Will I eat the flesh of bulls, or drink the blood of

goats? Offer unto God thanksgiving; and pay thy vows unto the most High:

Hebrews 9:12 Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption *for us*. Matthew 26:28 For this is my blood of the new testament, which is

shed for many for the remission of sins.

HIS ONLY SON THE FULFILLMENT OF PROPHETIC ISRAEL Messianic Kingdom

Israel: The anticipation of a Messianic Figure & Future Kingdom. Jesus: Christ's teachings about the Kingdom point to its ultimate fulfillment. Luke 24:21 But we trusted that it had been he which should have redeemed Israel: and beside all this, to day is the third day since these things were done. Luke 24:22-24 Yea, and certain women also of our company made us astonished, which were early at the sepulchre; And when they found not his body, they came, saying, that they had also seen a vision of angels, which said that he was alive. And certain of them which were with us went to the sepulchre, and found it even so as the women had said: but him they saw not. Luke 24:25-27 Then he said unto them, O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken: Ought not Christ to have suffered these things, and to enter into his glory? And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, he expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning himself.
