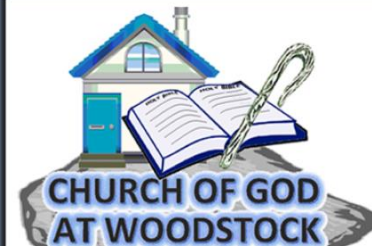

## Mark 9:23–24

And when he was come into the house, his disciples asked him privately, Why could not we cast him out? And he said unto them, This kind can come forth by nothing, but **by prayer and fasting**.

John 14:1-3

Hope

**Let not your hearts be troubled.** Believe in God; believe also in me. In my Father's house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that **I go to prepare a place for you?** And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, **that where I am you may be also.**





# Faith and Hope

Romans 8:24-25 (NLT)

Hope

We were given this **hope** when we were saved.  
(If we already have something, we don't need to hope for it. But if we look forward to something we don't yet have, we must wait patiently and confidently.)



# Faith and Hope

Hope

## Revelation 21:3–4

And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of **God is with men**, and **he will dwell with them**, and they shall be his people, and **God himself shall be with them**, and **be their God**. And God **shall wipe away all tears** from their eyes; and there shall be **no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain:** for the former things are passed away.

# Faith and Hope

A wrong focus destroys hope.

Hope

## Lamentations 3:18–20

And I said, My strength and **my hope is perished** from the LORD: **Remembering mine affliction and my misery, the wormwood and the gall.** My soul hath them still in remembrance, and is humbled in me.

## Psalms 73:2–3

But as for me, **my feet were almost gone**; my steps had well nigh slipped. For **I was envious at the foolish**, when I saw the prosperity of the wicked.



# Faith and Hope

Unfailing hope is found in God alone.

Hope

## Psalm 28:7–8

The **LORD is my strength and my shield**; my heart **trusted in him, and I am helped**: therefore my heart greatly rejoiceth; and with my song will I praise him. **The LORD is their strength**, and he is the saving strength of his anointed.

## Psalm 33:20–22

Our soul waiteth for the LORD: **he is our help and our shield**. For our heart shall rejoice in him, because we have trusted in his holy name. Let thy mercy, O LORD, be upon us, **according as we hope in thee**.



# Faith and Hope

Recalling God's faithfulness restores **Hope**  
lost hope.

**Lamentations 3:21–23**

**This I recall to my mind, therefore have I hope.**  
It is of **the LORD'S mercies** that we are not  
consumed, because **his compassions fail not.**  
They are **new every morning**: great is thy  
faithfulness.



# Faith and Hope

**Recalling God's faithfulness restores** **Hope**  
**lost hope.**

- He forgives all your sins.
- He heals all your diseases.
- He redeems your life from destruction.
- He crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies.
- He sets you free.
- He makes known His ways to you.
- He gives you His grace and mercy in times of need.

Now **faith** is the substance of things **hoped** for, the evidence of things not seen.

## Hebrews 11:6

But **without faith it is impossible to please him**: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him. **(faith and hope)**



# Faith and Hope

## Faith & Hope

Everyday life is filled with faithful actions, reasonable, evidence-based faith.

We take these actions because we hope.

### **For example:**

Flipping a light switch is an act of faith – we do it in full (faithful) expectation that the light will turn on (or off as the case may be)

In this case, our faith is the basis on which we take the action, the substance of our actions, in hope [earnest expectation], that the light will work.

# Faith and Hope

## 1 Peter 1:18–21

Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot: Who verily was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you, Who by him do believe in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; **that your faith and hope might be in God.**

Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of **faith**, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.
