

HOW TO DEEPEN HOPE



A wrong focus destroys hope.

Lamentations 3:18-20

And I said, My strength and my hope is perished from the LORD: Remembering mine affliction and my misery, the wormwood and the gall. My soul hath them still in remembrance, and is humbled in me.

Psalm 73:2-3

But as for me, my feet were almost gone; my steps had well nigh slipped. For I was envious at the foolish, when I saw the prosperity of the wicked.

Unfailing hope is found in God alone.

Hope

Psalm 28:7-8

The LORD is my strength and my shield; my heart trusted in him, and I am helped: therefore my heart greatly rejoiceth; and with my song will I praise him. The LORD is their strength, and he is the saving strength of his anointed.

Psalm 33:20-22

Our soul waiteth for the LORD: he is our help and our shield. For our heart shall rejoice in him, because we have trusted in his holy name. Let thy mercy, O LORD, be upon us, according as we hope in thee.

Recalling God's faithfulness restore: Hope lost hope.

Lamentations 3:21-23

This I recall to my mind, therefore have I hope. It is of the LORD'S mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not. They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness.



Recalling God's faithfulness restore: Hope lost hope.

- He forgives all your sins.
- He heals all your diseases.
- He redeems your life from destruction.
- He crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies.
- He sets you free.
- He makes known His ways to you.
- He gives you His grace and mercy in times of need.

Now **faith** is the substance of things **hoped** for, the evidence of things not seen.

Hebrews 11:6

But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him. (faith and hope)



Faith & Hope

Everyday life is filled with faithful actions, reasonable, evidence-based faith.

We take these actions because we hope.

For example:

Flipping a light switch is an act of faith – we do it in full (faithful) expectation that the light will turn on (or off as the case may be)

In this case, our faith is the basis on which we take the action, the substance of our actions, in hope [earnest expectation], that the light will work.
