

## Indicators of Unity DEFINITION

#### **U-ni-ty** (yoō'nĭtē)*n. pl.* **u-ni-ties**

- **1.a.** The state or quality of being one or united into a whole: "The Founding Fathers had abhorred the concept of parties, fearing that they would undermine the unity of the nation through factionalism" (Julia n E. Zelizer).
- **b.** The state or quality of being in accord; harmony: The judges ruled in unity on the matter.
- **c.** The state or quality of being unified in an aesthetic whole, as in a work of literature: *the novel's thematic unity.*
- d. A whole that is a combination of parts: a group of ideas that taken together constitute a unity.
- **2. Singleness or constancy of purpose or action; continuity**: "In an army you need unity of purpose" (Emmeline Pankhurst).
- 3. One of the three principles of dramatic structure derived by French neoclassicists from Aristotle's *Poetic*
- s, stating that a drama should have but one plot, which should take place in a single day and be confined to a single locale.
- 4. Mathematics a. The number 1.
- **b.** See identity element.



#### **UNITY**

- Strong's Hebrew Dictionary 3162. Tn¹ Yachad from 3161; properly, a unit, i.e. (adverb) unitedly:—alike, at all (once), both, likewise, only, (al-)together, withal. (Used 139 times in OT. Mostly rendered as 'together' in KJV also rendered once as 'alike' and once as 'unity'
- Strong's Greek Dictionary 1775. ενοτης henotes hen-ot-ace' from 1520; oneness, i.e. (figuratively) unanimity:—unity.



Philippians 2:1-2 If there be therefore any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any bowels and mercies, Fulfil ye my joy, that ye be likeminded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind.



## **IOU** Indicators of Unity PURPOSE OF UNITY

John 17:20-23 Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word; That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me. And the glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one: I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me.

#### **COMMANDED UNITY**

1 Corinthians 1:10 Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you; but that ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment. 1 Corinthians 1:11-13 For it hath been declared unto me of you, my brethren, by them which are of the house of Chloe, that there are contentions among you. Now this I say, that every one of you saith, I am of Paul; and I of Apollos; and I of Cephas; and I of Christ. Is Christ divided? was Paul crucified for you? or were ye baptized in the name of Paul?

## **IOU** Indicators of Unity UNITY SHOWS LOVE

1 Corinthians 13:4-7 Charity suffereth long, and is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up, Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil; Rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the truth; Beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things.



## **IOU** Indicators of Unity UNITY SHOWS LOVE

Ephesians 4:1-3 I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that ye walk worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called, With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love; Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

Philippians 2:3-5 Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves. Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others. Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:



#### **UNITY REQUIRES HUMILTY**

**Galatians 5:19-20** Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are *these*; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions,

**VARIANCE Strong's Greek Dictionary 2054. ερις eris** *er'-is* of uncertain affinity; a quarrel, i.e. (by implication) wrangling:—contention, debate, strife, variance.

STRIFE: Strong's Greek Dictionary 2052. εριθεια eritheia er-ith-i'-ah perhaps as the same as 2042; properly, intrigue, i.e. (by implication) faction:—contention(-ious), strife.

**SEDITIONS: Strong's Greek Dictionary 1370. διχοστασια dichostasia** *dee-khos-tas-ee'-ah* from a derivative of 1364 and 4714; disunion, i.e. (figuratively) dissension:—division, sedition.



**HERESIES: Strong's Greek Dictionary 139.** αιρεσις hairesis hah'-ee-res-is from 138; properly, a choice, i.e. (specially) a party or (abstractly) disunion:—heresy (which is the Greek word itself), sect.

#### **UNITY REQUIRES HUMILITY**

James 3:14-18 But if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth. This wisdom descendeth not from above, but is earthly, sensual, devilish. For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work. But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy. And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace of them that make peace.



#### **UNITY REQUIRES HUMILITY**

Philippians 1:16 The one preach Christ of contention, not sincerely, supposing to add affliction to my bonds:

**Titus 3:10-11** A man that is an **heretick** (causing division) after the first and second admonition reject; Knowing that he that is such is subverted, and sinneth, being condemned of himself.



#### **UNITY REQUIRES HUMILITY**

3 John 9-10 I wrote unto the church: but Diotrephes, who loveth to have the preeminence among them, receiveth us not. Wherefore, if I come, I will remember his deeds which he doeth, prating against us with malicious words: and not content therewith, neither doth he himself receive the brethren, and forbiddeth them that would, and casteth them out of the church.



#### **UNITY REQUIRES HUMILITY**

Galatians 5:14-15 For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this; Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. But if ye bite and devour one another, take heed that ye be not consumed one of another.

Galatians 5:26 Let us not be desirous of vain glory, provoking one another, envying one another.



#### **UNITY REQUIRES HUMILITY**

- 1 Peter 5:5 Likewise, ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yea, all of you be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility: for God resisteth the proud, and giveth grace to the humble.
- 1 Peter 5:6 Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time:



Mark 9:33-37 And he came to Capernaum: and being in the house he asked them, What was it that ye disputed among yourselves by the way? But they held their peace: for by the way they had disputed among themselves, who should be the greatest. And he sat down, and called the twelve, and saith unto them, If any man desire to be first, the same shall be last of all, and servant of all. And he took a child, and set him in the midst of them: and when he had taken him in his arms, he said unto them, Whosoever shall receive one of such children in my name, receiveth me: and whosoever shall receive me, receiveth not me, but him that sent me.  $_{\scriptscriptstyle 16}$ 



#### **UNITY REQUIRES HUMILITY**

Acts 4:32 And the multitude of them that believed were of one heart and of one soul: neither said any of them that ought of the things which he possessed was his own; but they had all things common.

Ephesians 5:21 Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God.



1 Peter 4:15 But let none of you suffer as a murderer, or as a thief, or as an evildoer, or as a busybody in other men's matters.

Proverbs 16:28 A froward man soweth strife: and a whisperer separateth chief friends.

Proverbs 17:9 He that covereth a transgression seeketh love; but he that repeateth a matter separateth very friends.



1 Corinthians 12:25-27 That there should be no schism in the body; but *that* the members should have the same care one for another. And whether one member suffer, all the members suffer with it; or one member be honoured, all the members rejoice with it. Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular.

Romans 12:16 Be of the same mind one toward another. Mind not high things, but condescend to men of low estate. Be not wise in your own conceits.



**Galatians 6:1** Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, **restore such an one in the spirit of meekness**; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.

James 5:19-20 Brethren, if any of you do err from the truth, and one convert him; Let him know, that he which converteth the sinner from the error of his way shall save a soul from death, and shall hide a multitude of sins.



Philippians 2:6-7 Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men:

John 17:5 And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was.



#### **UNITY REQUIRES HUMILITY**

**Ephesians 5:21** Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God.

1 Peter 5:5-7 Likewise, ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yea, all of you be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility: for God resisteth the proud, and giveth grace to the humble. Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time: Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.



#### **UNITY REQUIRES HUMILITY**

**Philippians 2:7-8** But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

**Ephesians 4:2-3** With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love; Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.



**Colossians 3:13** Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also *do* ye.

Amos 3:3 Can two walk together, except they be agreed?

John 10:30 I and my Father are one.



#### **UNITY REQUIRES HUMILITY**

Psalm 133:1-3 A Song of degrees of David. Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity! It is like the precious ointment upon the head, that ran down upon the beard, even Aaron's beard: that went down to the skirts of his garments; As the dew of Hermon, and as the dew that descended upon the mountains of Zion: for there the LORD commanded the blessing, even life for evermore.

#### **UNITY REQUIRES HUMILITY**

Ecclesiastes 4:9-12 Two are better than one; because they have a good reward for their labour. For if they fall, the one will lift up his fellow: but woe to him that is alone when he falleth; for he hath not another to help him up. Again, if two lie together, then they have heat: but how can one be warm alone? And if one prevail against him, two shall withstand him; and a threefold cord is not quickly broken.

#### **UNITY REQUIRES HUMILITY**

1 Corinthians 1:10-11 Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you; but that ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment. #### **UNITY REQUIRES HUMILITY**

Ephesians 4:13-16 Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ: That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive; But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ: From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love.

#### **UNITY REQUIRES HUMILITY**

John 17:21 That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me.

Romans 15:5-7 Now the God of patience and consolation grant you to be likeminded one toward another according to Christ Jesus: That ye may with one mind *and* one mouth glorify God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. Wherefore receive ye one another, as Christ also received us to the glory of God.





