
Psalm 139




Specific Revelation


John 20:28-31

And many other signs truly did Jesus in the presence of his disciples, which are not written in this book: But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name.

Psalm 139:1-6 [1]

O LORD, thou hast **searched** me, **and known** me.

John 10:27

My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:

Hebrews 4:13

Neither is there any creature that is not manifest in his sight: but all things are naked and opened unto the eyes of Him with whom we have to do.

Psalm 139:1-6 [2-3]

Thou knowest my downsitting and mine uprising, thou understandest my thought afar off. Thou compassest my path and my lying down, and art acquainted with all my ways.

Proverbs 16:9

A man's heart deviseth his way: but the LORD directeth his steps.

Job 31:4

Doth not He see my ways, and count all my steps?

Psalm 139:1-6 [4]

For there is **not a word in my tongue**, but, lo, O LORD, thou **knowest it altogether**.

Matthew 12:36

But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment.

Romans 2:16

In the day when God shall judge the secrets of men by Jesus Christ according to my gospel.

Psalm 139:1-6 [5]

Thou hast **beset me** behind and before, and **laid thine hand upon me**.

John 10:28-29

And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand. My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand.



- God knows everything about us.

Romans 5:8

But God commendeth **His love toward us**, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

Psalm 139:1-6 [6]

Such knowledge is **too wonderful** for me; it is high, I **cannot attain unto it**.

Revelation 21:3b-4

...and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God. And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.

Psalm 139:7-9

Whither **shall I go** from thy spirit? or whither **shall I flee** from thy presence? If I ascend up into heaven, **thou art there**: if I make my bed in hell, behold, **thou art there**. If I take the wings of the morning, and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea;



Luke 8:17

For nothing is **secret**, that shall not be made **manifest**; neither any thing **hid**, that shall not be **known and come abroad**.





Psalm 139:10

Even there shall thy hand **lead me**, and thy right hand shall **hold me**.

Hebrews 13:5

Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for He hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.



PSATM 139

Psalm 40:1-3

I waited patiently for the LORD; and he inclined unto me, and heard my cry. He brought me up also out of an horrible pit, out of the miry clay, and set my feet upon a rock, and established my goings. And he hath put a new song in my mouth, even praise unto our God: many shall see it, and fear, and shall trust in the LORD.



Psalms 139:11-12 (NLT)

I could ask the darkness to hide me and the light around me to become night, but even in darkness I cannot hide from you. To you the night shines as bright as day. Darkness and light are the same to you.

Psalms 139:11-12 (YLT)

And I say, Surely darkness bruiseth me, Then night is light to me. Also darkness hideth not from Thee, And night as day shineth, as is darkness so is light.

אויף – 17779 - shoof

A primitive root; properly to gape, that is, snap at; figuratively to overwhelm: - break, bruise, cover.

Genesis 3:15

And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall **bruise** thy head, and thou shalt **bruise** his heel.

Job 9:17

For he **breaketh** me with a tempest, and multiplieth my wounds without cause.

H2822 – חשׁך - kho-shek'

From H2821; the dark; hence (literally) darkness; figuratively misery, destruction, death, ignorance, sorrow, wickedness: - dark (-ness), night, obscurity.

Genesis 1:5

And God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And the evening and the morning were the first day.

Job 15:23

He wandereth abroad for bread, saying, Where is it? he knoweth that the day of **darkness** is ready at his hand.

Psalm 139:11-12

If I say, Surely the darkness shall cover me; even the night shall be light about me. Yea, the darkness hideth not from thee; but the night shineth as the day: the darkness and the light are both alike to thee.



Psalm 139:13-16

For thou hast possessed my reins: thou hast covered me in my mother's womb. I will praise thee; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made: marvellous are thy works; and that my soul knoweth right well. My substance was not hid from thee, when I was made in secret, and curiously wrought in the lowest parts of the earth. Thine eyes did see my substance, yet being unperfect; and in thy book all my members were written, which in continuance were fashioned, when as yet there was none of them.

Jeremiah 1:5

Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, and I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations.



Psalm 139:17-18

How precious also are thy thoughts unto me, O God! how great is the sum of them! If I should count them, they are more in number than the sand: when I awake, I am still with thee.



Psalm 40:5

Many, O LORD my God, are thy wonderful works which thou hast done, and thy thoughts which are to us-ward: they cannot be reckoned up in order unto thee: if I would declare and speak of them, they are more than can be numbered.



Psalm 139:19-22

Surely thou wilt slay the wicked, O God: depart from me therefore, ye bloody men. For they speak against thee wickedly, and thine enemies take thy name in vain. Do not I hate them, O LORD, that hate thee? and am not I grieved with those that rise up against thee? I hate them with perfect hatred: I count them mine enemies.



Psalm 1:1-2

Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night.

Psalm 40:4

Blessed is that man that maketh the LORD his trust, and respecteth not the proud, nor such as turn aside to lies.

2 Corinthians 6:14-18 [14-16]

Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness? And what concord hath Christ with Belial? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel? And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

PSATM 139

2 Corinthians 6:14-18 [17-18]

Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you, And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty.



Psalm 139:23-24

Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts: And see if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.



1 John 3:18-21

My little children, let us not love in word, neither in tongue; but in deed and in truth. And hereby we know that we are of the truth, and shall assure our hearts before him. For if our heart condemn us, God is greater than our heart, and knoweth all things. Beloved, if our heart condemn us not, then have we confidence toward God.



If you will receive it, Psalm 139 reveals to us

- 139:1-6 God is all knowing.
- 139:7-12 God is everywhere, always.
- 139:13-18 God is all loving and powerful.
- 139:19-22 God is worthy worthy of all our affections, not divided.
- 139:23-24 God is our only hope, and right well capable and willing to be so!

And to Him be all Honor, Glory and Praise forever!
