Miracles With Paul

Acts 7:58-59 And cast *him* out of the city, and stoned *him*: and **the witnesses laid down their clothes at a young man's feet, whose name was Saul**. And they stoned Stephen, calling upon *God*, and saying, Lord Jesus, receive my spirit. **Acts 8:1-4** **And Saul was consenting unto his death**. And at that time there was a great persecution against the church which was at Jerusalem; and they were all scattered abroad throughout the regions of Judaea and Samaria, except the apostles. And devout men carried Stephen *to his burial*, and made great lamentation over him. As for Saul, he made havock of the church, entering into every house, and haling men and women committed *them* to prison. Therefore they that were scattered abroad went every where preaching the word.

Miracles With Paul

Acts 22:4-5 And I persecuted this way unto the death, binding and delivering into prisons both men and women. As also the high priest doth bear me witness, and all the estate of the elders: from whom also I received letters unto the brethren, and went to Damascus, to bring them which were there bound unto Jerusalem, for to be punished.

Acts 22:19-20 And I said, Lord, they know that I imprisoned and beat in every synagogue them that believed on thee: And when the blood of thy martyr Stephen was shed, I also was standing by, and consenting unto his death, and kept the raiment of them that slew him.

Miracles With Paul

Acts 9:1-3 **And Saul, yet breathing out threatenings and slaughter against the disciples of the Lord,** went unto the high priest, And desired of him letters to Damascus to the synagogues, that if he found any of this way, whether they were men or women, he might bring them **bound** unto Jerusalem. And as he journeyed, he came near Damascus: and suddenly there shined round about him a light from heaven:

Miracles With Paul

Acts 9:4-9 And he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, **Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me?** And he said, Who art thou, Lord? And the Lord said, **I am Jesus whom thou persecutest: *it is* hard for thee to kick against the pricks.** And he trembling and astonished said, Lord, what wilt thou have me to do? And the Lord *said* unto him, **Arise, and go into the city, and it shall be told thee what thou must do.** And the men which journeyed with him stood speechless, **hearing a voice, but seeing no man.** And Saul arose from the earth; and when his eyes were opened, he saw no man: but they led him by the hand, and brought *him* into Damascus. And he was three days without sight, and neither did eat nor drink.

Miracles With Paul

Acts 9:10-12 And there was a certain disciple at Damascus, named Ananias; and to him said the Lord in a vision, Ananias. And he said, Behold, I *am here*, Lord. And the Lord *said* unto him, Arise, and go into the street which is called Straight, and inquire in the house of Judas for *one* called Saul, of Tarsus: for, behold, he prayeth, And hath seen in a vision a man named Ananias coming in, and putting *his* hand on him, that he might receive his sight.

Miracles With Paul

Acts 9:13-16 Then Ananias answered, Lord, I have heard by many of this man, how much evil he hath done to thy saints at Jerusalem: And here he hath authority from the chief priests to bind all that call on thy name. But the Lord said unto him, Go thy way: for he is a chosen vessel unto me, to bear my name before the Gentiles, and kings, and the children of Israel: For I will shew him how great things he must suffer for my name's sake.

Miracles With Paul

Acts 9:17-18 And Ananias went his way, and entered into the house; and putting his hands on him said, **Brother Saul, the Lord, *even* Jesus, that appeared unto thee in the way as thou camest, hath sent me, that thou mightest receive thy sight, and be filled with the Holy Ghost. And immediately there fell from his eyes as it had been scales: and he received sight forthwith, and arose, and was baptized.**

Miracles With Paul

Acts 9:19-21 And when he had received meat, he was strengthened. Then was Saul certain days with the disciples which were at Damascus. And straightway **he preached Christ in the synagogues, that he is the Son of God.** But all that heard *him* were amazed, and said; Is not this he that destroyed them which called on this name in Jerusalem, and came hither for that intent, that he might bring them bound unto the chief priests?

Miracles With Paul

Acts 9:22-23 But Saul increased the more in strength, and confounded **the Jews** which dwelt at Damascus, proving that this is very Christ. And after that many days were fulfilled, the Jews took counsel to kill him:

Acts 9:26-29 And when Saul was come to Jerusalem, he assayed to join himself to the disciples: but they were all afraid of him, and believed not that he was a disciple. **But Barnabas took him, and brought *him* to the apostles, and declared unto them how he had seen the Lord in the way, and that he had spoken to him, and how he had preached boldly at Damascus in the name of Jesus.** And he was with them coming in and going out at Jerusalem. **And he spake boldly in the name of the Lord Jesus,** and disputed against the Grecians: **but they went about to slay him.**

Miracles With Paul

Acts 11:25-26 Then departed Barnabas to Tarsus, **for to seek Saul**: And when he had found him, he brought him unto Antioch. And it came to pass, that a whole year they **assembled themselves with the church, and taught much people. And the disciples were called Christians first in Antioch.**

Miracles With Paul

Acts 13:1-3 Now there were in the church that was at Antioch certain **prophets and teachers**; as **Barnabas**, and **Simeon** that was called Niger, and **Lucius** of Cyrene, and Manaen, which had been brought up with Herod the tetrarch, and Saul. **As they ministered to the Lord, and fasted, the Holy Ghost said, Separate me Barnabas and Saul for the work whereunto I have called them.** And when they had fasted and prayed, and laid *their* hands on them, they sent *them* away.

Miracles With Paul

Acts 13:6-9 And when they had gone through the isle unto Paphos, they found a certain **sorcerer**, a false prophet, a Jew, whose name *was* **Barjesus**: Which was with the deputy of the country, **Sergius Paulus**, a prudent man; who called for Barnabas and Saul, and desired to hear the word of God. But **Elymas the sorcerer (for so is his name by interpretation) withstood them, seeking to turn away the deputy from the faith.** Then Saul, (who also *is called* Paul,) filled with the Holy Ghost, set his eyes on him,

2 Corinthians 4:3-4 But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost: In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.

Miracles With Paul

Acts 13:10-12 And said, O full of all subtilty and all mischief, *thou* child of the devil, *thou* enemy of all righteousness, wilt thou not cease to pervert the right ways of the Lord? And now, behold, the hand of the Lord *is* upon thee, and **thou shalt be blind, not seeing the sun for a season. And immediately there fell on him a mist and a darkness; and he went about seeking some to lead him by the hand. Then the deputy, when he saw what was done, believed, being astonished at the doctrine of the Lord.**

Miracles With Paul

Acts 14:8-10 And there sat a certain man at Lystra, **impotent in his feet, being a cripple from his mother's womb, who never had walked:** The same heard Paul speak: who stedfastly beholding him, and perceiving that he had **faith** to be healed, Said with a loud voice, **Stand upright on thy feet. And he leaped and walked.**

REFERENCE: *Romans 10:17* So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Miracles With Paul

Acts 14:19-20 And there came thither *certain* Jews from Antioch and Iconium, who persuaded the people, and, having **stoned Paul**, drew *him* out of the city, **supposing he had been dead**. Howbeit, **as the disciples stood round about him, he rose up**, and came into the city: and the next day he departed with Barnabas to Derbe.

Strong's Greek Dictionary 3543. νομιζω nomizo *nom-id'-zo* (from 3551 nomos); **properly, to do by law** (usage), i.e. to accustom (passively, **be usual**); by extension, **to deem or regard**:— suppose, think, be wont.

supposing = reckoning. Gr. nomizo. This word, which occ. fifteen times, always means to conclude from custom, law, or evidence, never to imagine. (Bullinger's Companion Bible Notes)

Miracles With Paul

Acts 16:16-18 And it came to pass, as we went to prayer, a certain **damsel possessed with a spirit of divination** met us, which brought her masters much gain **by soothsaying**: The same followed Paul and us, and cried, saying, **These men are the servants of the most high God, which shew unto us the way of salvation**. And this did she many days. But Paul, being grieved, turned and **said to the spirit, I command thee in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her**. And he came out the same hour.

Miracles With Paul

Acts 16:26-28 And suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken: and immediately **all the doors were opened, and every one's bands were loosed.** And the keeper of the prison awaking out of his sleep, and seeing the prison doors open, he drew out his sword, and would have killed himself, supposing that the prisoners had been fled. But Paul cried with a loud voice, saying, Do thyself no harm: for we are all here.

Miracles With Paul

2 Corinthians 12:12

**Truly the signs of an apostle
were wrought among you in
all patience, in signs, and
wonders, and mighty deeds.**

Miracles With Paul

Acts 19:11-12 And God wrought special miracles by the hands of Paul: So that from his body were brought unto the sick handkerchiefs or aprons, and the diseases departed from them, and the evil spirits went out of them.

Hebrews 8:6 But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also he is the mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises.

Hebrews 11:35 Women received their dead raised to life again: and others were tortured, not accepting deliverance; that they might obtain a better resurrection:

Albert Barnes Commentary: Verse 11. Special Miracles. Miracles that were remarkable; that were not common, or that were very unusual, ΟΥ ΤΑΣ ΤΥΧΟΥΣΑΣ. This expression is classic Greek. Thus Longinus says of Moses, that he was no common man. ΟΥΧ Ο ΤΥΧΩΝ ΑΝΗΡ.

Miracles With Paul

Acts 20:7-9 And upon the first *day* of the week, when the disciples came together to break bread, Paul preached unto them, ready to depart on the morrow; and continued his speech until midnight. And there were many lights in the upper chamber, where they were gathered together. And there sat in a window a certain young man named **Eutychus**, being fallen into a deep sleep: and as Paul was long preaching, he sunk down with sleep, and fell down from the third loft, and was **taken up dead**.

Miracles With Paul

Acts 20:10-12 And Paul went down, and fell on him, and embracing *him* said, Trouble not yourselves; for his life is in him. When he therefore was come up again, and had broken bread, and eaten, and talked a long while, even till break of day, so he departed. **And they brought the young man alive, and were not a little comforted.**

REF Elijah in 1 Kings 17:21 And he stretched himself upon the child three times, and cried unto the LORD, and said, O LORD my God, I pray thee, let this child's soul come into him again.

Miracles With Paul

Acts 28:1-3 And when they were escaped, then they knew that the island was called Melita. And the barbarous people shewed us no little kindness: for they kindled a fire, and received us every one, because of the present rain, and because of the cold. And when Paul had gathered a bundle of sticks, and laid *them* on the fire, **there came a viper out of the heat, and fastened on his hand.**

Miracles With Paul

Acts 28:4-6 And when the barbarians saw the *venomous* beast hang on his hand, they said among themselves, No doubt this man is a murderer, whom, though he hath escaped the sea, **yet vengeance suffereth not to live. And he shook off the beast into the fire, and felt no harm. Howbeit they looked when he should have swollen, or fallen down dead suddenly:** but after they had looked a great while, and saw no harm come to him, **they changed their minds, and said that he was a god.**

Miracles With Paul

Acts 28:7-9 In the same quarters were possessions of the chief man of the island, whose name was Publius; who received us, and lodged us three days courteously. And it came to pass, that **the father of Publius lay sick of a fever and of a bloody flux:** to whom **Paul entered in, and prayed, and laid his hands on him, and healed him. So when this was done, others also, which had diseases in the island, came, and were healed:**

Miracles With Paul


Romans 15:17-19 I have therefore whereof I may glory through Jesus Christ in those things which pertain to God. **For I will not dare to speak of any of those things which Christ hath not wrought by me, to make the Gentiles obedient, by word and deed, Through mighty signs and wonders, by the power of the Spirit of God; so that from Jerusalem, and round about unto Illyricum, I have fully preached the gospel of Christ.**
